SAP Statement on June 24 Joint Discovery Statement in Oracle v. SAP

SAN FRANCISCO, Calif. — June 24, 2008 — Today, Oracle and SAP filed a joint discovery statement in Oracle v. SAP. In the statement, Oracle made certain claims that SAP addressed. The statement is posted at www.tnlawsuit.com, and a relevant excerpt from SAP's portion of the statement is quoted here:

“Oracle’s complaints about ‘fair play’ are belied by its own rhetoric about alleged damages. Oracle speculates wildly about the amount of its damages ‘claim’ in this discovery report, even though more than a year after this case was filed, Oracle still refuses to identify with any precision the nature or amount of its alleged harm or even to provide the theory on which its damage claim is based.”

The court filing speaks for itself and represents SAP’s complete statement on the matter.
