

SAP Statement On Agreement With U.S. Department of Justice

September 14, 2011- Walldorf, Germany and Newtown Square, Pennsylvania - SAP AG announced today that it has reached an agreement with the US Attorney's Office in San Francisco, California, to resolve charges arising out of that Office's investigation of the activities of TomorrowNow, Inc. and to conclude the investigation. As part of the agreement, TomorrowNow, Inc. has pled guilty to eleven counts of violations of the U.S. Computer Fraud & Abuse Act and one count of criminal copyright infringement, and has agreed and will pay a fine of \$20,000,000 (US). The business operations of TomorrowNow, Inc. were discontinued in 2008. No other SAP entity, including SAP AG or SAP America, will face charges arising out of the Office's investigation. The plea agreement was approved by the U.S. District Court today. We believe that the resolution of this investigation is fair. We are pleased to have come to an appropriate conclusion of this process.
