SAP Statement on April 24 Case Management Conference in Oracle v. SAP

SAN FRANCISCO, Calif. — April 24, 2008 — Today in the Northern District Court in San Francisco, SAP and Oracle met with Judge Phyllis J. Hamilton to conduct the third case management conference in Oracle v. SAP. This was the first case management conference in front of Judge Hamilton, who was recently assigned to the case. In the discussion, the Judge reviewed the discovery process, deposition limits and confirmed that the schedule for alternative dispute resolution would remain in place. This process includes mediation, scheduled for May 29, 2008, and a settlement conference scheduled for October 6, 2008. The Judge will issue an order on the decisions in the case management in approximately one week. Once issued, we will post the order to www.tnlawsuit.com.
